

HATHERN is a parish, village, and railway station, distant 3 miles from Loughborough, in the north division of the county, hundred of West Goscote, union and county court district of Loughborough, diocese of Peterborough, archdeaconry of Leicester, and rural deanery of Akeley. The church is dedicated to St Peter. The living is a rectory, annual value £529, with residence, in the gift and incumbency of the Rev. E. Smythies. The Baptists, Wesleyans, Wesleyan Reformers, and Primitive Methodists, have each a chapel here. There is a National school for boys and girls, J. Lammos master. The parish contains 1290 acres of land, of which the chief owners are A. L. P. de Lisle, Esq. (lord of the manor), Wyggeston's Hospital, and Christ's College, Cambridge. The population is about 1100. Letters arrive at 8 a.m., are dispatched at 6 p.m. The nearest money-order and telegraph office is at Sheepshed. Post-town, Loughborough.
